Students will present their report to the class upon completion.


Musical

- Write a rap or song to tell about your topic.



Linguistic Intelligence

- Write a poem to tell about your topic.
- Make an ABC book.
- Create a picture dictionary .
- Create a brochure.
- Write a report. The report should be a minimum of one typed page or be written neatly.
- Write a screen play.



Intrapersonal

- Research a famous person. Write a journal entry as that person.
- After reading a biography, compare and contrast character traits of that person with your own traits.

Bodily–Kinesthetic

- Make up a dance to tell about your topic.

Interpersonal Intelligence

- ☺ Interview an expert on your topic and share a summary of that conversation.
- ☺ Create a documentary.
- ☺ Write a campaign speech or advertisement in support of your topic. Be ready to share it with the class!
- ☺ Learn about a famous person and come dressed as that person to tell their story to the class!

Logical/Mathematical

- Make a time line.
- Create a Power Point presentation.

Visual / Artistic

- Paint or draw a picture to tell about the topic that you researched.
- Construct a diorama or a mobile!
- Make a comic strip.
- Make a scrap book.
- Take pictures pertaining to your topic and place them on a display board with captions.
